They were removed to Thoresby Park in 1879, and some papers have been added to them since. Included in the collection are about five hundred letters, sixteen of which are from King Louis XV., in his own handwriting, to Jean Antoine Francois, Comte de Coigny, son of the first Due de Coigny, who was killed in a duel with the Prince de Dombes in 1748. A good many letters are from Monsieur Chamillard, Minister of War under Louis XIV. for a time, to the Comte de Coigny. There are also letters from Marshal de Tallard, Marshal Villeroy; Louis Auguste de Bourbon, Due du Maine; François Louis de Bourbon, - Prince de Conty; Louis de Bourbon; Louis, Due de Vendome; Marshal de Noailles, Marshal Montmorency Luxembourg, Marquis de Barbesieux, De Louvois,...
